TOPIC & GOALS

Sympathy, empathy, compassion... are terms quoted regularly in describing the attitude of palliative care professionals and volunteers. They are often used despite some key notable differences. We will take a closer look at what exactly is the „quality“ that we expect from ourselves and our staff and that we want to offer our patients and their relatives.

Is empathy like a muscle? Can we train it in our staff?
Can we look for it in the recruitment process? Is it possible and necessary for our teams to have a uniform understanding of these concepts?
