

Trans-national Train-the-Trainer Workshop

A two-day seminar offers an opportunity for palliative care trainers from CEE and SEE to get to know new and useful work skills and tools.

The seminar will focus on sharing (and learning) methods for Hospice & Palliative Care trainings in diverse settings. By comparing the work practice and attitudes in the participants' training situations, we will learn from each other and reflect on our own strengths and talents.

Experienced trainers will be at hand to offer theoretical input (e.g. on group dynamics), moderate the exchange within the group and present various tools and methods that address needs and questions from the group.
